**Sub:** Request for intervention to bring back students stuck abroad due to corona pandemic.

Dear Sir,

I, Manoj Kumar Agarwal, a resident of H.no: 1-10-98/10, Dwaraka das colony, Begumpet, Hyderabad, Telangana - 500016, would humbly request your intervention in bringing back the students including my son Darshit Agarwal, holding Passport No.N5989194 and one Darshan Vimal Nahar holding Passport No. N7601790 who is **stuck in London, United Kingdom**. Like them there are many other students who are eager to come back. They are in constant touch with the Indian Embassy in London but they are not getting any help or assistance. There are students who are in the age group of 21 to 25. The students are not getting proper food due to isolation. They are also suffering from mental depression and anxiety neurosis. Earlier also we were in touch with the high officials of state government, ministry of external affairs and Indian embassy London but to our utter disappointment there is no response. As a responsible government it is the duty of the government to take care of its citizens wherever they are located and that too when they are young children. The plight of the students is unbearable and if immediate action is not taken most of them may fall sick.

Even though the health care systems are advanced there, the numbers of reported cases are at 1, 33, 495 and the numbers of deaths are 18, 100 as it stand. The local authorities are unable to provide sufficient help to the students and this is really worrying especially with our children being in the epicenter of this mass spread.

Under these circumstances, I would humbly request your intervention in bringing back the students that are stuck there. We request you to intervene and strongly write to the central government to make necessary arrangements as when the regular international flights will restart is uncertain. We as parents are losing patience and even we are facing health breakdown.

I confirm and agree to all necessary precautions including Quarantine once they reach here.

Hoping that you will do the needful in this regard.
