About EXPO 2020

World Expo 2020 Dubai

World Expo 2020 Dubai, the first Expo to take place in the Middle East, Africa and South Asia (MEASA) region, is open between 1 October 2021 and 31 March 2022. The Expo theme is Connecting Minds, Creating the Future. The Sub themes of the Expo are Opportunity, Mobility and Sustainability.

World Expo 2020 is being organized by building a completely new Expo city half-way between Dubai and Abu Dhabi, at Jebel Ali. World Expo 2020 is expected to be the largest till date with 190 countries have already confirmed participation. More than 25 million visitors are expected to visit over a period of 6 months to attend the event.

World Expo is one of the oldest and biggest events on the planet. Every five years, a city takes its turn to host the occasion, which lasts six months at a time and invites every country in the globe to take part in showcasing the best of what they have to offer.

Its aim is to help people and Nations across the Earth learn by sharing ideas, at the same time demonstrating innovation and further paving the path for progress in fields such as technology and architecture.

About India Pavilion at Dubai Expo

India Pavilion was built on a plot of 4614 sq. meters with a display area of about 10,000 sq. meters. The immediate neighbours of the Indian pavilion are Germany, Japan, USA, Italy, Singapore, Kazakhstan who are setting up their Pavilions. The entire exposition in India pavilion is going to be of a dynamic nature. For example, the 1st floor will showcase one state at a time for a minimum period of 7 days and maximum period of 14 days.

The top floor will while have permanent companies, their exposition will also change with the change in the theme of the expo. When expo is celebrating Tourism, the companies participating will showcase their expertise in Tourism, likewise for automation, healthcare, space, renewables, agriculture etc. The sectoral display containing Central Ministries will be on 2nd floor and will also follow the same dynamic model as the 1st floor. This will give the visitors to the India pavilion, insight into the multifaceted dimension of the Indian economy and maintain the growing interest of visitors. The outside area of the India pavilion will have an amphitheater and a retail area and food court and fine dining facility.

Telangana State Industrial Infrastructure Corporation is a Telangana State Government initiative for providing infrastructure through development of industrial areas. TSIIC was established in the year 2014 for identifying and developing potential growth centers in the Telangana State fully equipped with developed plots/sheds, roads, drainage, water, power and other infrastructural facilities; providing social infrastructure and other facilities. The Corporation also has active projects in the Public-Private Partnership Mode.

The corporation has so far developed more than 300 industrial parks spreading over an extent of about 1,21,655 acres (including allotted area).

A 16-member FTCCI Industrial Delegation got an opportunity to meet Mr. EV Narasimha Reddy, VC & MD, TSIIC on the sidelines of Expo 2020 Dubai during the Telangana week. The business delegation apprised Mr. Narasimha Reddy on the business potential they see, not just in UAE Markets but across the globe. They emphasized on improving the industrial and business ecosystem in the state. "Infrastructure facilitation and bringing in more technological upgradation is the key to success," said Mr.

Bhasker Reddy, the President of FTCCI.

The Saudi Pavilion offers a glimpse into our shared future, taking you on a journey through our ambitions across four main pillars: people, nature, heritage and opportunities. It is the second largest pavilion at Expo 2020 Dubai with a total area of 13,059 sqm.

A delegation of government officials and business leaders from India visited the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's Pavilion at Expo 2020 Dubai, to celebrate historic ties between the two nations and to find out more about the lucrative investment opportunities in the Kingdom under its ambitious Saudi Vision 2030 which are open to all investors from around the world.



Coming under the 'Kingdom of Saudi Arabia-India Day', The objective is to celebrate historical relationships through having business engagement plans and cultural exchanges.

The Indian delegation toured the Saudi Pavilion, a uniquely-designed five-story structure that is the second largest country representation at Expo 2020 Dubai after the UAE's. Saudi Arabia's participation in the six-month Expo 2020 Dubai - running from October 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022 - is underpinned by four key pillars - People, Heritage, Nature and Opportunity. Through rich and varied content, the pavilion seeks to offer visitors a unique experience that reflects the image of the Kingdom as it is today under Saudi Vision 2030, its ambitious roadmap for the future, while emphasizing pride in identity, history, heritage, and people.

The Indian delegation that visited the Saudi Pavilion included from the government side Dr. Srikar Reddy, Joint Secretary of Foreign Trade WANA, the division dealing with India's trade with WANA region comprising of 19 countries, including Saudi Arabia and other Gulf and MENA nations.
