ORDER:

In exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Act, 2014 (Act No.3 of 2014), Government have issued Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Rules,2015 vide G.O.3rd read above for implementation of the provisions of the said Act.

2. In order to facilitate the investors by providing investor friendly environment, mandate time-bound delivery of all services, Government vide G.O.s 4th to 12th read above, issued certain amendments to Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Rules, 2015 issued in G.O. 3rd read above and brought certain services pertaining to establishment and operation of the Industries under TS-iPASS Rules.
3. In the reference 13th read above, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India communicated State Reform Action Plan for the year 2020 with 301 reforms out of which 19 services are to be delivered within specific timelines mandated by Public Service Delivery Guarantee Act.

4. In the reference 14th read above, it was proposed to issue orders consolidating the establishment/operation/renewal and other services for which the time limits are mandated through Public Service Delivery Guarantee Act.
5. Government after careful examination decides to recognize TS-iPASS Act as Public Service Delivery Guarantee (PSDG) Act for the services/reforms that are co-ordinated by DPIIT, Government of India and hereby issues a revised Annexure-VI consolidating all the services included in 4th to 12th read above.
6. Accordingly, the following amendments are issued to the TS-iPASS Rules(amended from time to time) to authorize the Government for making any changes in the Common Application Form(CAF), for mandating ONLINE application, for modification of the penalty amount and for including additional services in the Annexure VI of TS-iPASS Rules:

The Companies Act 2013 provides the legal basis for various corporate governance norms that are considered essential for the proper corporate operation and protection of stakeholders' rights. Violations of such norms are defined as offences with associated penalties. Sometimes, it may lead to the Arrest of such person, Director (s), or Key Managerial Persons.

Investigation into the affairs of a company is assigned to the Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO), which always alerts the Corporates on Corporate Frauds and leads to the consequence of being arrested or prosecuted.

The objective of this Webinar is to get awareness among the Corporates, business community, professionals and Individuals about the consequences of any shortcomings or violations of the Sections or Rules of the Companies Act, which may lead to the Arrest of the person and also alert the companies on such consequences.
