## PRESS NOTE

The Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad & the Competent Authority under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, has declared the average State Industrial Workers Consumer Price Index Numbers for the half year ending December, 2022 as follows:-

**Part-I (Industrial Workers) : Increase of 74 points from 1659 to 1733**

**Part-II (Agricultural Workers): Increase of 42 points from 1260 to 1302**

These are applicable for the period from 01.04.2023 to 30.09.2023 in various Scheduled Employments notified under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, in the State of Telangana for the purpose of calculation of Variable Dearness Allowance.

### Order:-

In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad in the letter read above., Government after careful examination of the matter hereby decide to issue guideline for granting exemption from section 7 (Opening and Closing hours) of the Telangana Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 to all Shops & Establishments as defined in section 2 (21) of the Telangana Shops & Establishments Act, 1988 for operating 24/7 in the Telangana State subject to certain conditions.

2. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Telangana State Gazette:

## NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (4) of section 73 of the Telangana Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 (Act 20 of 1988), the Government of Telangana hereby issue guidelines for granting exemption from section 7 (Opening and Closing hours) of the Telangana Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 to all Shops & Establishments as defined in section 2 (21) in the Telangana Shops & Establishments Act, 1988 for operating 24/7 in the Telangana State, subject to following conditions namely:-

- (i) Issue o ID cards,
  - (ii) Weekly off,
  - (iii) Weekly workinghours,
  - (iv) Overtime wages,
  - (v) Compensatory holiday with wages in lieu of employees attending duty on a notified national / festival holiday,
  - (vi) Adequate safety of Women employees,
  - (vii) Consent of women employee to work in night shift,
  - (viii) To and fro transport from Women employees working in night shift
  - (ix) The Management shall maintain the records and furnish returns as prescribed by the State Government within time.
  - (x) Subject to compliance of provisions under the Police Act & Rules in force, and
  - (xi) Subject to payment of annual fee of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) for each store to open 24x7 under the Telangana Shops and Establishments Act 1988
3. The Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action in the matter accordingly.

**Subject : Direction under Section 18(2)(d) read with Section 16(5) of Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 regarding re-operationalisation of FSS )Health Supplements, Natraceuticals, Food for Special Dietary Use, Food for Special Medical Purpose and Prebiotic and Probiotic Food) Regulations, 2022**

In exercise of the power conferred under Section 92 of the Food Safety and Standards Act,2006, FSSAI has framed draft FSS (Health Supplements, Nutraceuticals, Food for Special Dietary Use, Food forSpecial Medical Purpose and Prebiotic and Probiotic Food) Regulations, 2022 and the same were operationalised vide direction dated 29.03.2022 supersending the FSS (Health Supplements, Nutraceuticals, Food for Special Dietary Use, Food for Special Medical Purpose, Functional Food and Novel Food) Regulations, 2016. The direction of 29.03.2022 was further revised vide direction dated 10.05.2022 to permit additional food additives and enzyme/proteins for Health Supplements.

2. The provisions of these draft regulations as specified in the direction dated 29.03.2022 together with the provisions specified in the direction dated 10.05.2022, were re-operationalised with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2022 vide direction dated 18.10.2022. As the finalization of these draft regulations is likely to take some more time before being notified, it has been decided to again re-operationalise the provisions specified in the direction dated 18.10.2022, with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023.
3. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority in exercise of the power vested under Section 18(2)(d) and 16(5) of Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006.
