Circular MemoNo.3440/FP&MSME/2022,

Sub: Ind. & Com. Dept - Implementation of the Government purchase & Price preference Policy - Grant of benefits to Micro & Small Scale Units Registered with NSIC Regarding.

Ref: From Director of Industries, Hyd, Lr.No.COI-MSME/MARK/6/2022, T:19.09.2022

In the reference cited, the Director of Industries, Telangana State, Hyderabad, has stated that the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, New Delhi, have provided the following benefits to Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs) registered with National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), a public sector undertaking under the administrative control of the Ministry.

- 1. Issues of Tender sets free of costs
- 2. Exemption from payment of Earnest Money.
- 3. Price preference up to 15% to MSEs over the quotation of large scale units.
- 4. Central Ministry / Department / PSUs shall set an annual target for 25% procurement from MSE sector. A sub-target of 4% out of 25% target of annual procurement earmarked for procurement from MSEs owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs.
- 5. Special provision for Micro and Small Enterprises owned by Women category up to 3 percent from within the 25% target shall be earmarked for procurement
- 2. Further it is informed that the NSIC has been rendering valuable marketing support to micro and small enterprises in marketing their products to the various Government Departments and also informed that it also makes verification of genuineness of the unit and does a proper assessment in respect of the capacity of the unit and the financial capability of the unit to execute the purchase order before registering a unit under its Single Point Registration Scheme.
- 3. Therefore, all the indenting Departments in the State are requested to avail the services of NSIC in Government Purchases/tenders and encourage the local Micro and Small Enterprises registered with NSIC.
