2. In this connection, many references are being received from various field offices regarding SOP on Joint Declaration, as the functionality in the application software has not been developed as yet.
3. Since the IT tool is under development, the Joint Declarations may be taken in offline mode as well. Further, the instructions issued in the SOP under reference, such as Parameters, classification of changes, competent authority to approved changes and documentary proofs to be submitted by members at the time of submission of member profile correction, roles and responsibilities of officers/Officials in the field offices, procedures, frequency of changes, authorities to attest the claims in case of closed establishment, timelines of completing the JD, monitoring mechanism and all other relevant directions shall be strictly adhered to.

FSSAI initiates prosecution against FBOs found violating food safety laws

New Delhi, September 14, 2023: The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI), the country's apex food regulator, has taken stern action against Food Business Operators (FBOs) found to be violating food safety laws. According to the records, 1,411 prosecution cases have been initiated against FBOs found violating the provisions of the Food Safety and Standards (FSS) Act, 2006 since April 1, 2023.

The prosecution initiated against the FBOs covers different violations committed, including carrying out a food business without a valid license and manufacturing or selling unsafe food. Since the beginning of this financial year, a number of food products across various categories like milk and milk products, spices, packaged drinking water, nutraceuticals, sauces, pickles, chips, jaggery, etc. have been tested to ensure compliance with product standards and safety of the same.

FSSAI, along with States/UTs Food Authorities is continuously monitoring the quality and safety of food products for consumers in the country by drawing and testing samples. FBOs found to be in violation of the rules are liable to face fines and legal action under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006. The FSSAI seeks to prevent non-compliant practices and ensure that consumers across the nation have access to safe and high-quality food products through stringent inspections, monitoring, and enforcement campaigns.

FSSAI strongly advises all FBOs to follow the standards of food products prescribed by FSSAI and ensure safe and hygienic practices for the manufacturing of food products. Any noncompliance may result in strict action against the violating FBOs.
