Trade Notice – 11/2025-26

Subject: Revision of Active SIONs pertaining to food items – reg.

It has been noted that certain SIONs of food items contain generic input descriptions, while in others, the quantities of alternative inputs are not clearly specified. Such ambiguities may lead to misinterpretation or possible misuse of the norms.

- 2. In view of the sensitive nature of food items, Norms Committee-6 has decided to undertake a comprehensive review of SIONs: E-1, E-4, E-5, E-7, E-38, E-46, E-75, E-76, E-77, E-100, E-101, E-102, E-127, E-132, and E-13,3, and General Notes associated with SIONs.
- 3. In this context, comments, suggestions, and feedback are hereby invited from exporters, importers, industry associations, and other stakeholders regarding the revision of SIONs mentioned above.

MACHINERY AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT SAFETY (OMNIBUS TECHNICAL REGULATION) AMENDMENTORDER, 2025

The "Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety (Omnibus Technical Regulation) Amendment Order, 2025" mends the Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety (Omnibus Technical Regulation) Order, 2024 published in the Gazette of India on 28th August, 2024. The Amendment Order stipulates the following:

- (i) The regulation will apply from 1st September, 2026 to all machines and electrical equipment listed in the first Schedule of the principal Order.
- (ii) Assemblies, sub-assemblies and components listed in the first Schedule of the principal Order shall apply from such date as may be notified by the Central Government in the Official Gazette.

Each machine, or as the case may be, electrical equipment specified in the first Schedule of the Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety (Omnibus Technical Regulation) Order, 2024 shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standards, as applicable, as given below:-

- (i) Type A standards as given below: IS 16819:2018/ISO 12100:2010 (Safety of Machinery General Principles for Design-Risk Assessment and Risk Reduction and,
- (ii) Type B Standards –as per the second schedule;
- (iii) Type C Standards as per the third Schedule: provided that if a Type C standard deviates from one or more technical provisions dealt with by Type A or Type B standard, Type C standard takes precedence.

Compliance for machines and electrical equipment in the first Schedule will commence from 1stSeptember, 2026. Assemblies, sub-assemblies, and components will be brought under the regulation from the date to be notified in the Official Gazette. The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) has been notified as certifying and enforcement authority.

The details of exemptions provided are mentioned below:

- (i) Goods manufactured domestically for export;
- (ii) Construction equipment covered under the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, issued by MoRTH;
- (iii) Products already covered under other orders issued under Section 16 of the BIS Act, 2016.

To support the industry, especially small and medium-sized enterprises, in adapting to the "Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety (Omnibus Technical Regulation) Order, 2024" the Government has undertaken following measures:

- Portal for pre-registration for domestic manufacturers started on 23.10.2024 and till 31.07.2025, 494 domestic manufactures have pre-registered on portal.
- (ii) Awareness programs have been conducted in collaboration with Industry Association, Ministry of Heavy Industries and Bureau of Indian Standards.

Department of Posts Announces Suspension of Booking of Mail to the United States of America

In continuation of the Public Notice dated August 22, 2025, the Department of Posts has reviewed the suspension of booking of mail to the United States of America.

In view of the ongoing inability of carriers to transport U.S.-bound mail and in the absence of defined regulatory mechanisms, it has been decided to completely suspend the booking of all categories of mail, including letters, documents, and gift items valued up to USD 100, destined for the USA.

The Department is closely monitoring the situation and making every effort to restore services at the earliest. Customers who have already booked items that could not be dispatched may claim a refund of postage.

The inconvenience caused to valued customers is sincerely regretted.

Certification of Origin & Attestation of Export Documents

The Chamber is recognized by the Government of India to issue Certificates of Origin for non-preferential countries. Export documents are also accepted as authentic by the Consular offices of various countries and international authorities.

VISA FACILITATION

The letters of recommendation are issued to Embassies and Consulates for issue of business visa to representatives of member companies for business travel.
