ORDER:

In the reference 1st read above, the Government of India has notified the Construction & Demolition (C&D) Waste Management Rules, 2025, mandating scientific management of C&D waste, including Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) and utilization of processed waste and it has been observed that indiscriminate dumping of C&D waste continues within GHMC, CMC, and MMC areas, resulting in environmental degradation, blockage of drains and nalas, and increased risk of urban flooding.

2. Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby direct the Commissioners, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation/Cyberabad Municipal Corporation/ Malkajgiri Municipal Corporation, the Metropolitan Commissioner, Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority, the Managing Director, Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited, the Managing Director, HAML, Managing Director, HRDCL, the Managing

The Telangana Southern Power Distribution Company Limited (TGSPDCL) has introduced a dedicated WhatsApp Chatbot (8712441912) to provide consumers with quick, convenient, and secure access to electricity-related services and grievance redressal. By saving the number and sending a simple "Hi" message, consumers can register and track power supply complaints, check and pay electricity bills, receive power outage updates, access various consumer services, and verify bill details to avoid fraudulent payment requests. The initiative offers a single digital platform for prompt resolution of consumer grievances while enhancing transparency, accessibility, and service delivery through technology-driven solutions.

Director, HGCL, the Managing Director, HMWSSB, the Commissioner, HYDRAA, the Managing Director, MRDCL, the Engineer-in-Chief, R&B, the Vice Chairman & Managing Director, TGIIC and the Managing Director, TGSPDCL within CURE Area to ensure strict and immediate compliance with the provisions of the C&D Waste Management Rules, 2025. The key instructions are as follows:-

1. Mandatory Compliance (Rule 4):

- ▶ Dumping or disposal of C&D waste in open areas, roadsides, drains, nalas, water bodies, or public places within GHMC, CMC, and MMC limits is strictly prohibited and shall attract penal action.
- ▶ All C&D waste shall be transported only to authorized C&D waste processing facilities. Disposal at unauthorized locations shall be treated as a violation.
- ▶ Every waste generator shall be fully responsible for the collection, segregation, storage, transportation, processing, disposal, and utilization of C&D waste in an environmentally sound manner.
- ▶ Waste generators shall ensure source segregation and channelization of C&D waste to authorized recyclers, and maximize utilization of processed C&D waste and recycled products in construction activities.
- ▶ No construction, demolition, or infrastructure activity shall be undertaken without:
 - 1) Ensuring proper disposal of C&D waste; and
 - 2) Incorporating processed C&D waste materials wherever applicable.

2. Mandatory Requirements in Building Permissions:

All buildings, layout, and all Demolition approvals shall mandatorily include:

- ▶ Undertaking against illegal dumping Linkage with authorized C&D waste recyclers submission of:
 - ▶ Waste Management Plan
 - ▶ Waste Utilization Plan according to rules 8 of C&D Waste Management rules 2025
- ▶ No Occupancy Certificate (NOC) shall be issued without compliance.

3. Utilization of Processed C&D Waste (Rules 8 & Schedules I–III):

- ▶ Use of processed C&D waste is mandatory in:
 - ▶ Construction projects with built-up area $\geq 20,000$ sq.m.
 - ▶ All road and infrastructure works
- ▶ Processed C&D waste shall be utilized in:
 - ▶ Sub-base and base layers
 - ▶ Non-structural concrete
 - ▶ Paver blocks, kerbs, and tiles
 - ▶ Backfilling and landscaping

- ▶ Road works shall mandatorily utilize processed waste in:
 - ▶ Embankments
 - ▶ Sub-grade and sub-base layers
 - ▶ Shoulders and medians

4. Execution of Works (All Departments):

All civil and infrastructure works (roads, drains, ipelines, utilities, metro, industrial works, etc.) shall:

- ▶ Include contractor undertaking against illegal dumping of C&D waste
- ▶ Ensure mandatory tie-up with authorized C&D recyclers
- ▶ Ensure complete site clearance and disposal of C&D waste before completion
- ▶ No work shall be closed or billed without submission of a **C&D Waste Disposal Certificate**.

5. Road Cutting Permissions:

All road cutting permissions within GHMC, CMC, and MMC limits shall mandatorily require:

- ▶ Undertaking against illegal dumping
- ▶ Proof of tie-up with authorized C&D waste recyclers.

6. Monitoring:

All Departments shall submit monthly data to GHMC, CMC, and MMC regarding:

- ▶ Works under execution
- ▶ Quantity of C&D waste generated
- ▶ Disposal details

7. User Charges:

Applicable user charges for collection, transportation, and processing of C&D waste shall be levied as per notified rates.

8. Penal Action:

- ▶ Strict action shall be taken for violations, including:
 - ▶ Imposition of penalties and cost recovery
 - ▶ Seizure of vehicles involved in illegal dumping
 - ▶ Withholding of permissions
 - ▶ Blacklisting of contractors and agencies.
- ▶ Any obstruction, resistance, law and order issue, or any untoward incident during the enforcement operations, the concerned police department shall extend necessary assistance at the site to facilitate smooth execution of the enforcement activity appropriate legal action shall be initiated by the police against the persons involved, in accordance with the provisions of law, based on complaint lodged by the authorize enforcement officers.

9. Accountability:

All Commissioners, Department Heads, and Nodal Officers shall be personally responsible for enforcement of these instructions. Any lapses will be viewed seriously.

10. Compliance Report:

An Action Taken Report shall be submitted within

30 days from the date of issue of this Circular.

All Departments and Agencies shall utilize only the following authorized facilities:

12. Integration in Policy & Tender Documents (Incl. eProcurement Tenders):

- ▶ Inclusion in Schedule of Rates (SoR): All departments shall notify standardized rates for recycled materials and bound products to ensure ease of adoption in public works by contractors.
- ▶ Mandatory Clause in Tenders: All civil works shall mandatory use 10% constructions material made out of C&D waste in all Government works in CURE Area. In case of non-availability of material, a certificate shall be issued by waste processing facilities and exemption shall be given accordingly.
- ▶ Proof of Compliance Mechanism: Link contractor payments to documented utilization of recycled materials sourced from authorised C&D processing facilities.
- ▶ Departmental Alignment: Ensure all urban local bodies, development authorities, and state departments such as GHMC, CMC, MMC, HMDA, HMRL/HAML, HRDCL, HGCL, HMWSSB, HYDRAA, MRDCL, R&B, TGIIC and TGSPDCL

align their DPRs, BOQs, and tender (incl. E Procurement) documents accordingly.

- ▶ Monitoring Framework: All Government departments should nominate respective nodal officers for target etting of annual utilization/ offtake target & its monthly monitoring to ensure compliances across projects.

3. With effect from 01 April 2026, this G.O. shall apply to all ongoing and future construction, demolition, infrastructure, road, utility, and public works projects and to all C&D Waste Generators, in accordance with the Construction & Demolition (C&D) Waste Management Rules, 2025.

4. All the concerned departments shall take necessary further action in the matter accordingly.
