OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Publication of Model Service Agreement for “Electrolyser as a Service” (EAAS) - reg.

The National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM) was launched with the objective of making India a global hub for the production, usage, and export of Green Hydrogen and its derivatives.

2. To accelerate the adoption of Green Hydrogen across various industrial sectors, the Ministry has noted the emergence of the ‘Electrolyser as a Service’ (EASS) business approach. Under this model, technology providers can establish, own, and operate electrolytic hydrogen generation plants at the consumer’s premises, thereby mitigating the upfront capital expenditure for the consumer.

3. To facilitate ease of doing business, reduce transaction costs, and minimize the time

taken in contract negotiations between project developers and consumers, the Ministry has prepared a Model service Agreement for ‘Electrolyser as a Service’ (EAAS).

4. This Model Agreement outlines standard industry practices regarding the devision of responsibilities, performance guarantees, threshold energy consumption metrics, and risk allocation mechanisms.

5. **Disclaimer:** It is hereby clarified that this Model Agreement is being issued purely as a facilitative and reference document. Market participants, project developers, and offtakers are free to mutually negotiate, alter, modify, add or delete any clauses and numbers based on their specific commercial requirements, risk appetite, and project-specific technical parameters. The Ministry shall not be liable for any legal or commercial disputes arising out of the execution of agreements based on this model.

Subject: Inputs on proposed amendment to Para 2.57 of FTP 2023 relating to de minimis exemption from RCMC requirements for low-value exports – regarding.

Reference is invited to Para 2.57 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023, which prescribes the requirement of Registration-cum-Membership Certificate (RCMC) or Certificate of Registration for availing authorisations, benefits and concessions under the FTP.

2. In line with Para 1.07A of FTP 2023, which provides for stakeholder consultations during the formulation and amendment of the Foreign Trade Policy, a draft amendment to Para 2.57 of FTP 2023 has been formulated to provide a de minimis exemption from the requirement of RCMC or Certificate of Registration for low-value export consignments. The proposed amendment Notification is enclosed as Annexure-I to this Trade Notice.

3. This Directorate invites views, suggestions and comments from exporters, industry associations and other stakeholders on the proposed amendment. Stakeholders may submit their inputs within 10 days from the date of issuance of this Trade Notice. Suggestions and comments may be sent by email to e-commerce-dgft@gov.in.

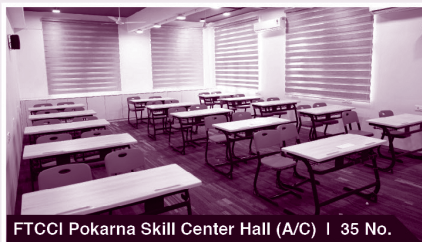

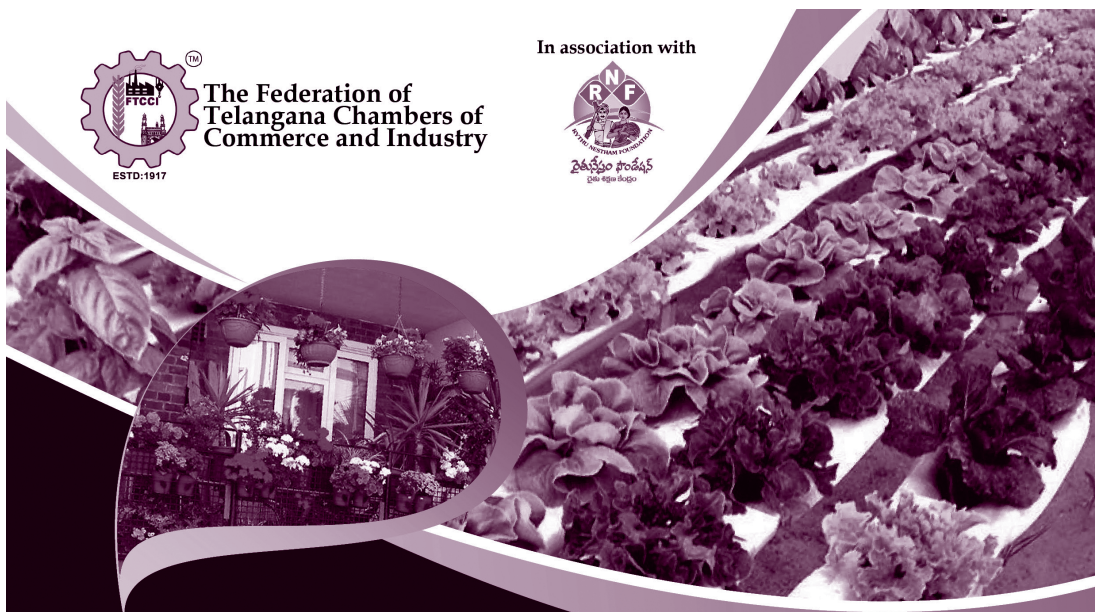
