Parliament had recently passed three Labour Code Bills, viz, "Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code (OSHWCC) Bill", "Code on Social Security (CSS) Bill", "Industrial Relations Code (IRC) Bill" merging 25 Central Labour Laws. The implementation of these Codes changes the existing employment models, salary structure of employees, policies & processes and companies need to be prepared for the financial implications due to these changes.

It is important for the companies and commercial establishment to understand the nuances of the regulations to enhance their readiness to be compliant with these Labour Codes.
