Amendment to the Master Direction - Credit Card and Debit Card – Issuance and Conduct Directions, 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 35A of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 and Chapter IIIB of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934, the Reserve Bank of India being satisfied that it is necessary and expedient in the public interest to do so, hereby, amends certain provisions issued vide Master Direction DoR.AUT.REC.No.27/24.01.041/2022-23 dated April 21, 2022 on 'Credit Card and Debit Card – Issuance and Conduct Directions, 2022'.

2. The amended provisions of the Master Direction are enclosed in the Annex to this circular. Frequently Asked Questions relating to the provisions contained in the Master Direction are placed under FAQ Section on the website and as an Appendix to the Master Direction.

3. Commencement

The amended provisions contained in this circular shall come into effect from March 07, 2024. The captioned Master Direction is hereby updated to reflect the changes effected by the below amendments.

4. Applicability

- Instructions relating to credit cards shall apply to all credit card issuing Banks and Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs).
- Instructions relating to debit cards shall apply to every bank operating in India

**Public Notice No. 46 /2023
New Delhi, Dated 06th March, 2024**

Subject: Amendments in Implementation of Yellow Peas Import Monitoring System-reg.

In exercise of powers conferred under Paragraph 1.03 and 2.04 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023, as amended from time to time, and in reference to Notification 50/2023 dated 08.12.2023 and Notification 61/2023 dated 23.02.2024, the Director General of Foreign Trade hereby amends the procedures for registration of import consignments under Yellow Peas Import Monitoring System (VP-IMS) for import consignments which are to arrive at the Indian Port after 31.03.2024 as follows -

- i. Para (b) of Public Notice 35/2023 dated 13.12.2023 shall not be applicable. In lieu of VP-IMS registration 5 days before the expected date of arrival of import consignment, the Importer shall undertake VP-IMS registration within 7 days from the date of Bill of Lading or 7 days from the date of this Public Notice, whichever is later.
- ii. Bill of Lading (Shipped on Board) details shall be declared in the VP-IMS registration. Multiple Bills of Lading (Shipped on Board) details may be specified under a single VP-IMS registration.
- iii. All copies of Bills of Lading(Shipped on Board) should be mandatorily uploaded during the registration process. The Importer may choose to mask the Exporter details on the said Bills of Lading copies.

(E): In exercise of powers conferred under paragraph 1.03 and 2.04 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP), 2023, the Director General of Foreign Trade hereby created a new Appendix i.e. Appendix 2Y under FTP, 2023 with immediate effect for notifying the list of Ministries/Departments whose notifications on mandatory QCOs, that are exempted by the DGFT for goods to be utilised/consumed in manufacture of export products.
